Amy commented, "I really enjoyed Classical Civilisations as the best way to understand our modern world is to examine the ancient foundations it has been built upon."






In 2012, **Fahem Chowdhury** progressed to study Actuarial Science at the University of Manchester after achieving an A*, an A and two Bs at A level.

Upper Sixth student, Jamela Khanum, studies BTEC Level 3 Health & Social Care, Sociology and English Literature.


